We are excited to announce we will have our 8th Annual Coleman Old Fashioned Craft Show on November 22nd. The school is being rebranded and we do not have the name yet. I decided to go ahead and send out the applications because everyone is getting antsy about it already being sold out. We have had the show for over 25 years; the name has changed. Our show benefits the WISD Student in Need Fund every year. This year, we have given thousands of dollars' worth of food to families in need. We were able to have four food distributions to families that struggle with food issues daily. We also sponsored a food drive at the end of the year for students that go hungry without our school food. We sent home a stockpile of food for those students to have a go to on food. We are hopeful that they will hook up with Waxahachie CARE to supply them. Most of these parents are among the working poor. Their parents work and make enough to keep a roof over their head.

We are looking forward to another great show. Last year's show had over 100 vendors and over 1000 attended. We hope that this year we will return to our normal number of 2000-2500 shoppers. Our show is a Waxahachie tradition. It is always the Saturday before Thanksgiving and a wonderful opportunity for shoppers to get started on their Christmas shopping. Though the High School moved, Walmart and HEB have not. It is in the middle of Waxahachie's shopping.

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### **The facts:**

**Please submit the application before August 1<sup>st</sup> for priority of placement. I must receive return vendors by August 1<sup>st</sup> to guarantee the same placement.**

**Please pay a \$20 late fee for submission after November 1<sup>st</sup>. We will accept applications until we fill up or on November 19<sup>th</sup>.**

- Set up will begin at 7:00a.m. on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. We will have student volunteers help you move your belongings in and out of the building.
- Call or e-mail me if you have any questions. I do not give out your booth numbers before the day of the show. However, our check-in process is very quick.
- The admission will be \$3 for shoppers. Vendors do not pay an admission fee.
- Craft Show hours are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- You must bring your own tables, chairs, and electrical cords. Electricity is not placed in the booth so bring a long extension cord if you need electricity.

### **Fees:**

- \$80 + \$20 Deposit The deposit will be returned at the end of the show. Booths are 10' across by 8' deep.
- \$20. Late Fee After November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Electricity is \$10. YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN EXTENSION CORDS.

- We will have assistance from the Waxahachie sports teams, National Honor Society etc. student councils helping you into and out of the show.
